

Building decking

The area of a rectangle = length × width

You want to build a patio area 4 m long and 3 m wide for your garden, using decking.

At your local DIY store they sell suitable planks of wood that are 2 m long and 0.25 m wide. They cost £3.95 each.



Calculate:

- 1. The patio area.
- 2. The area of each plank.
- 3. The amount of wood you'll use.
- 4. The total cost of the wood.

Now compare your answers with those on the answer sheet.
