

Creating Adjectives Using the Suffix -ive

This week, we are going to look at how we can create adjectives using a particular suffix...

-ive

which simply means 'tending to' or 'having the nature of'.

We will look at how the -ive suffix can be added to nouns or verbs to create adjectives.
