


Can you help me please?! Some important people need some patterns designed and I can't do it all by myself!








Cinderella has been invited to the ball but her fairy godmother is away on holiday! Can you design a pattern to go on her ball gown?

Batman has just moved into a new house and the wallpaper is PINK! He has asked his butler to find a new wallpaper for him. Can you help?




