Learning through play

This week the children have been learning about paramedics, we have spoken a lot about the role they play in helping during an emergency.

The children have also enjoyed making bread and eating it in school as part of their snack.

Maths This week the children have been problem solving and exploring different ways of making the numbers 1 2 and 3. We have also practised writing them.

Phonics This week we have been learning the new sounds 'o, c, k. We have practising writing the sounds using the rhymes. We, continue to work on rhyming words, fine motor skills and learning new vocabulary.
