# The Messy Magpie Adding the Suffix -ed

Can you sort the past-tense verbs into the correct columns?

Some verbs just add - <b>ed.</b>	If the verb already ends in the letter ' <b>e</b> ', <b>remove</b> the ' <b>e</b> ' and <b>add -ed</b> .	If the verb ends in a <b>consonant</b> and a <b>'y'</b> , the <b>'y'</b> becomes an <b>'i'</b> before you add -ed.	If the verb ends with <b>one</b> <b>vowel</b> and <b>one</b> <b>consonant</b> , <b>double the</b> <b>consonant</b> before adding -ed.
