This week

Our question this half term is, 'Does the whole world have a winter wonderland?' We have been looking at maps to see where the Inuit people live and discussing their life style including eating habits.

Maths

We have been learning to share an amount and add and subtract week using the language : less , more, fewer, the same, subtract, minus, plus add.

Phonics

We are now working in groups with some children working with set 1 sounds and others on set 2 sounds. This week we have learned to read write and spell with the letter sounds:
