Our question this half term is, 'Does the whole world have a winter wonderland?' This week we have been looking at Artic animals and have learned lots of facts about Polar Bears.

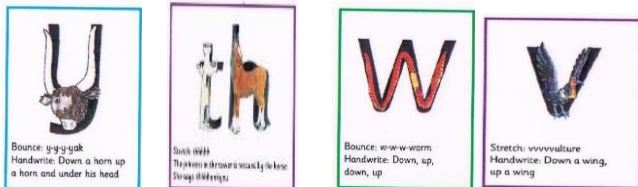
Maths
